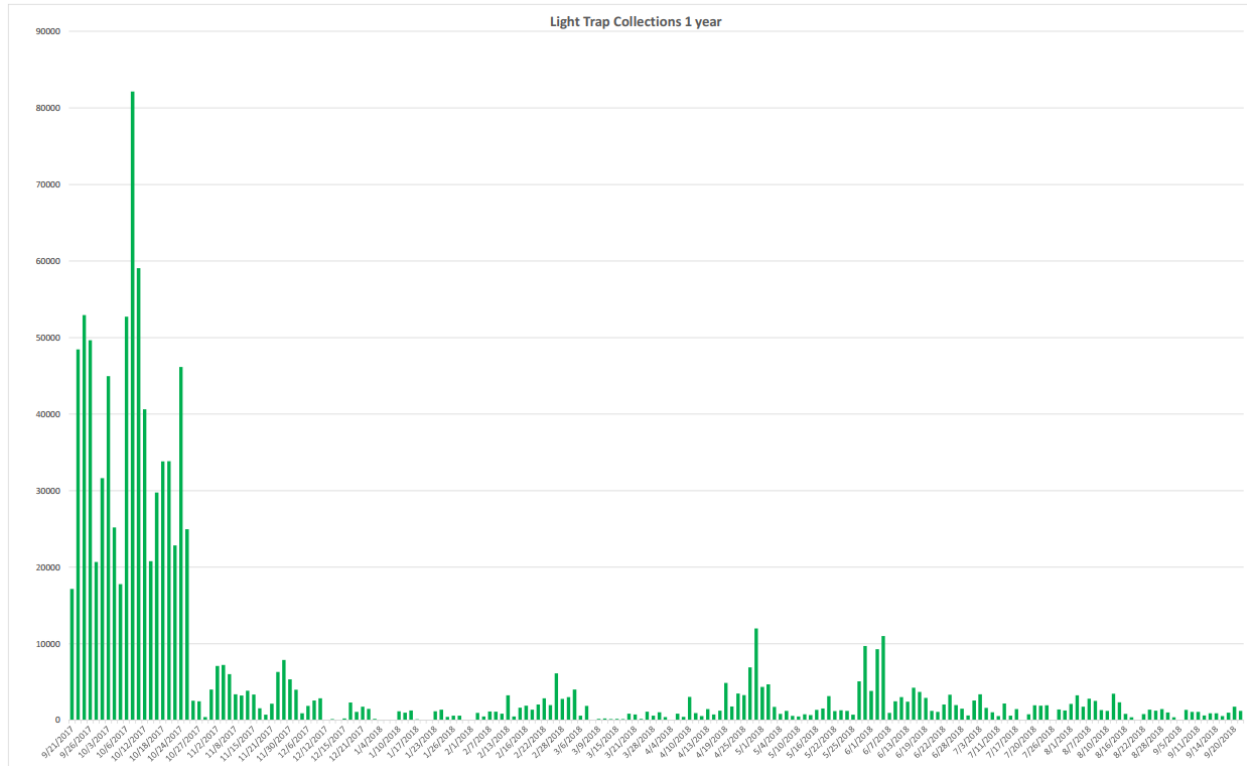
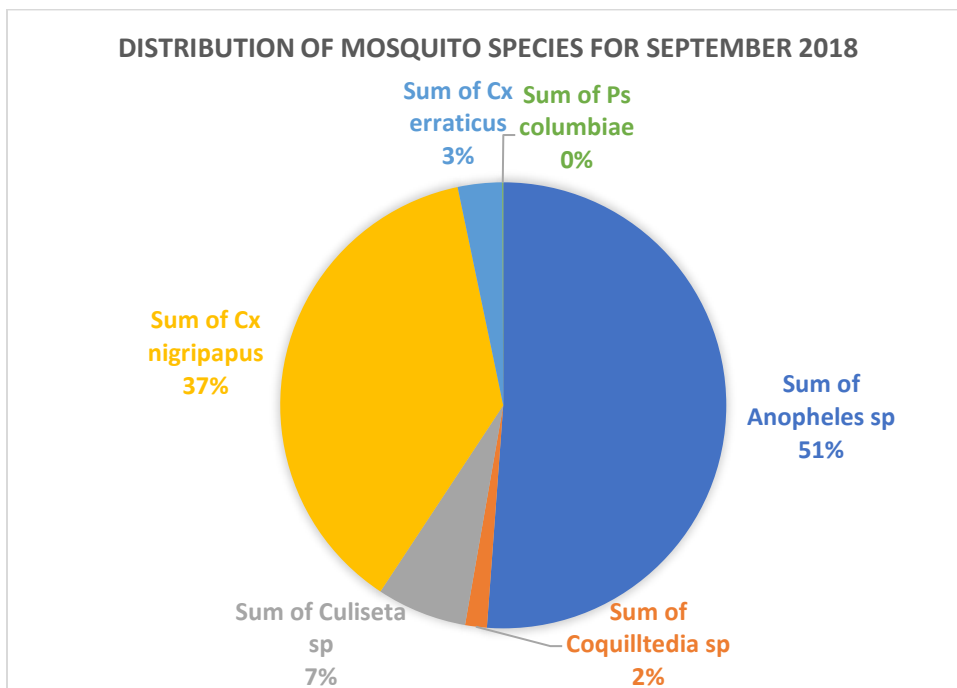


Week of 9/17/2018 Operations Update

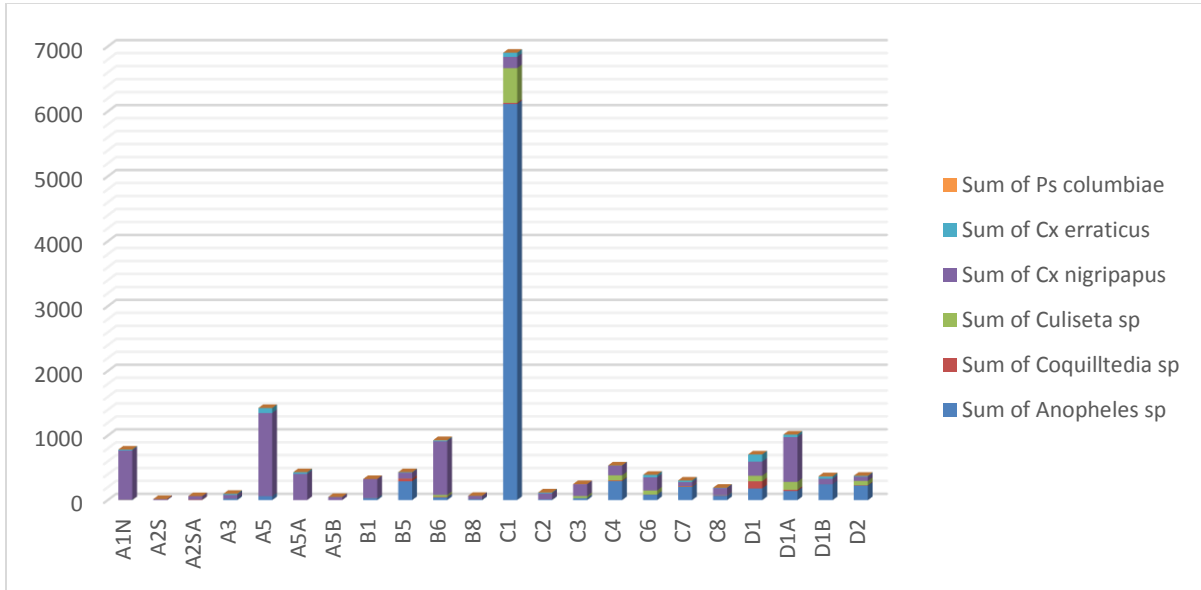
Mosquito populations remain at low levels.



There have been no heavy rain events for several weeks and our trapped mosquitoes reflect this. Anopholes and Culex species lay their eggs on water. *Culex nigripalpus* is of concern because it can transmit West Nile Virus, and this is the peak time of year for occurrence of this disease.



Anopheles are mostly confined to one trap which is located near zone C1 but is just outside the District.
