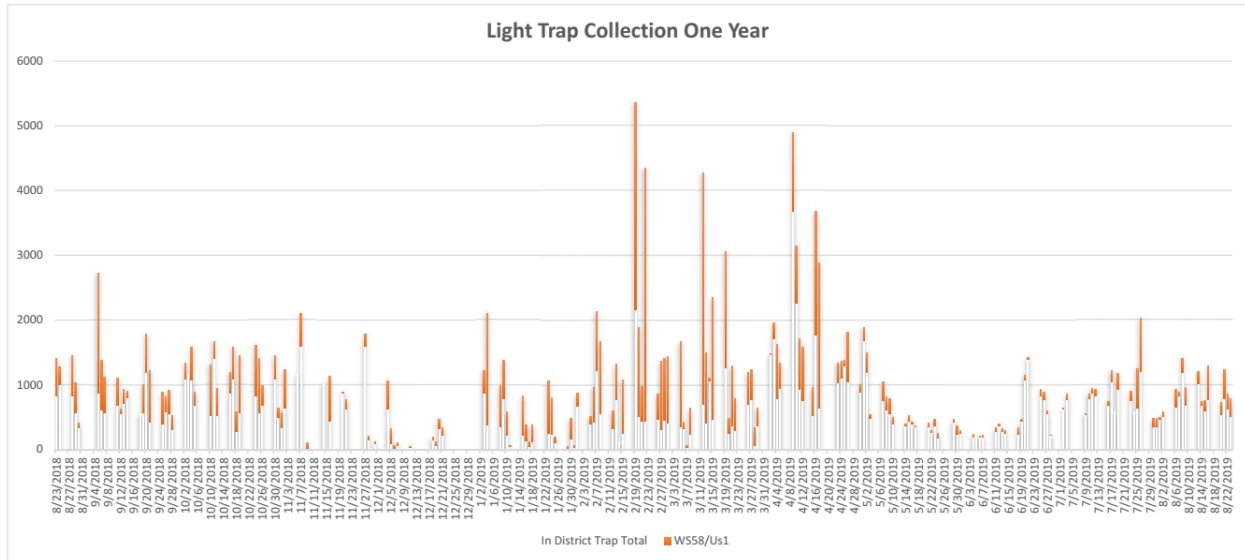
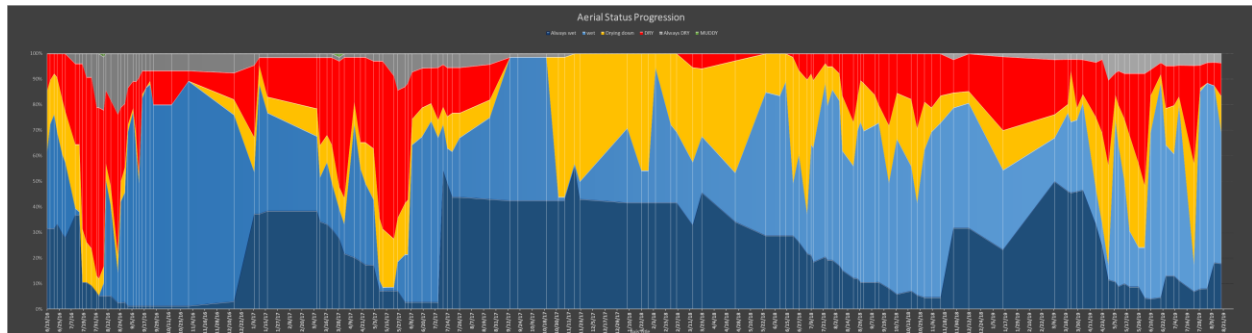


## Week of 8/19/2019 Operations Update

*Culex nigripalpus* was trapped in sufficient quantities to justify limited treatments, but overall low activity this week. The stacked-bar graph below shows the total mosquitoes from all traps in the District in white. The red is the sole trap we keep on the West-side of US-1 to monitor outside the District.



We are expecting to see flooding in the high-saltmarsh areas due to the Proxigean tide occurring on August 30. Pre-treatments of larvicide were done in anticipation of this event. The chart below shows the water status of large breeding areas monitored by helicopter in the saltmarsh.



Zones in yellow were sprayed by truck.
