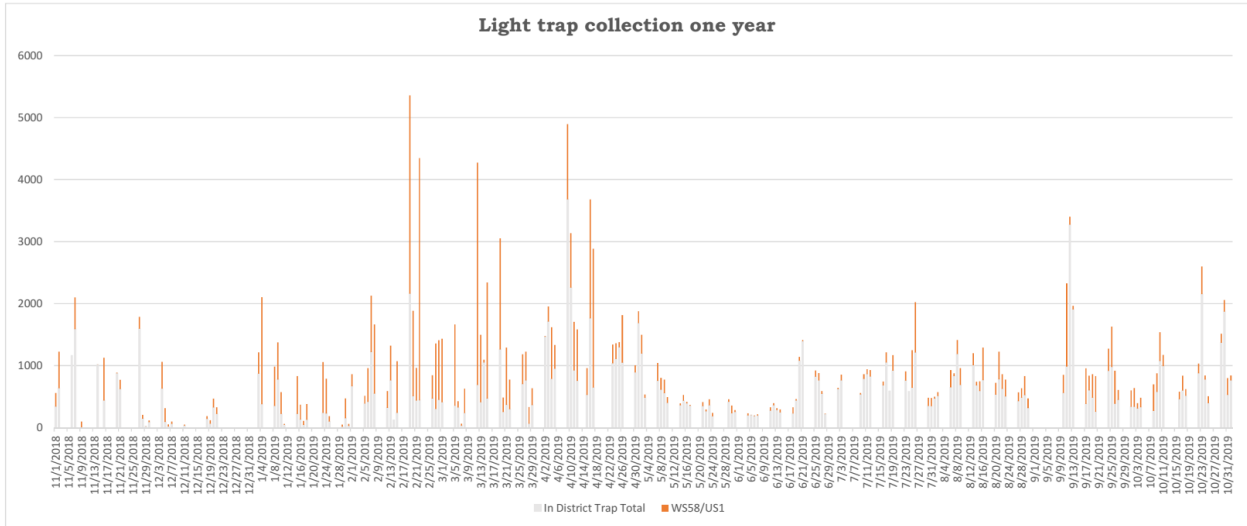
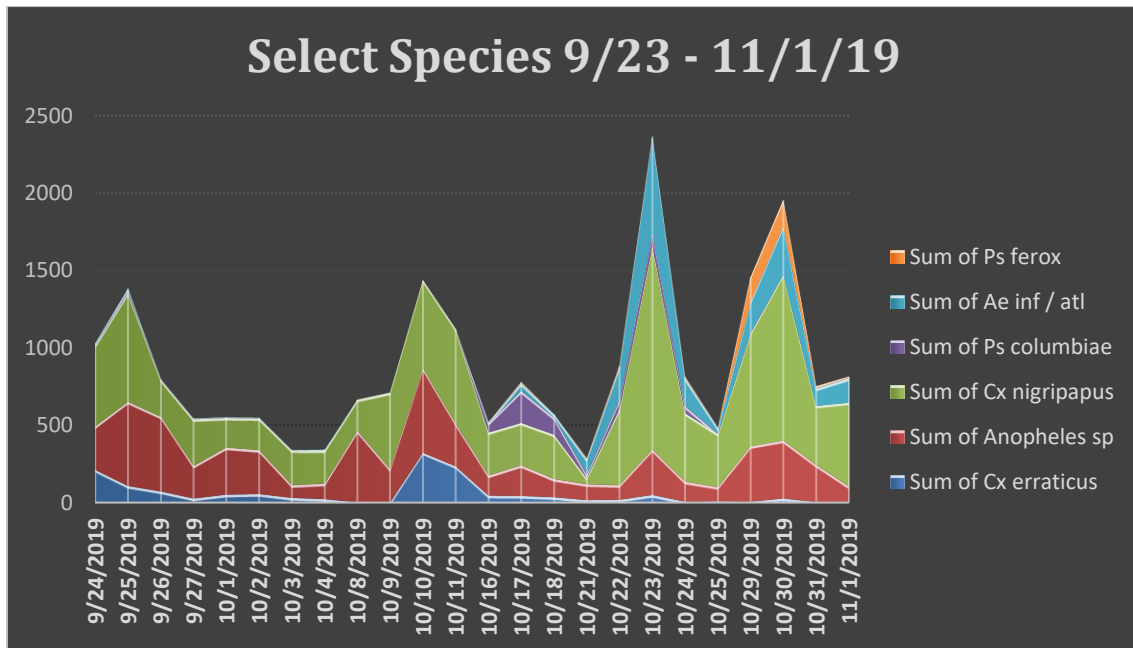


Week of 10/28/2019 Operations Update

District-wide adultciding this week ahead of Halloween. The stacked-bar graph below shows the total mosquitoes from all traps in the District in white. The red is the sole trap we keep on the West-side of US-1 to monitor outside the District.



Rainfall from Tropical Storm Nestor (10/19/19) and resultant standing water produced District-wide flood-water mosquito populations as well as a surge in *Culex nigripalpus* about ten days post-storm (we had mentioned the likelihood of needing to treat around Halloween in the last weekly update). You can see in the graph below that the total population and the different species vary in abundance and even presence.



Zones in yellow were sprayed by truck. Blocks in blue were treated by helicopter.
