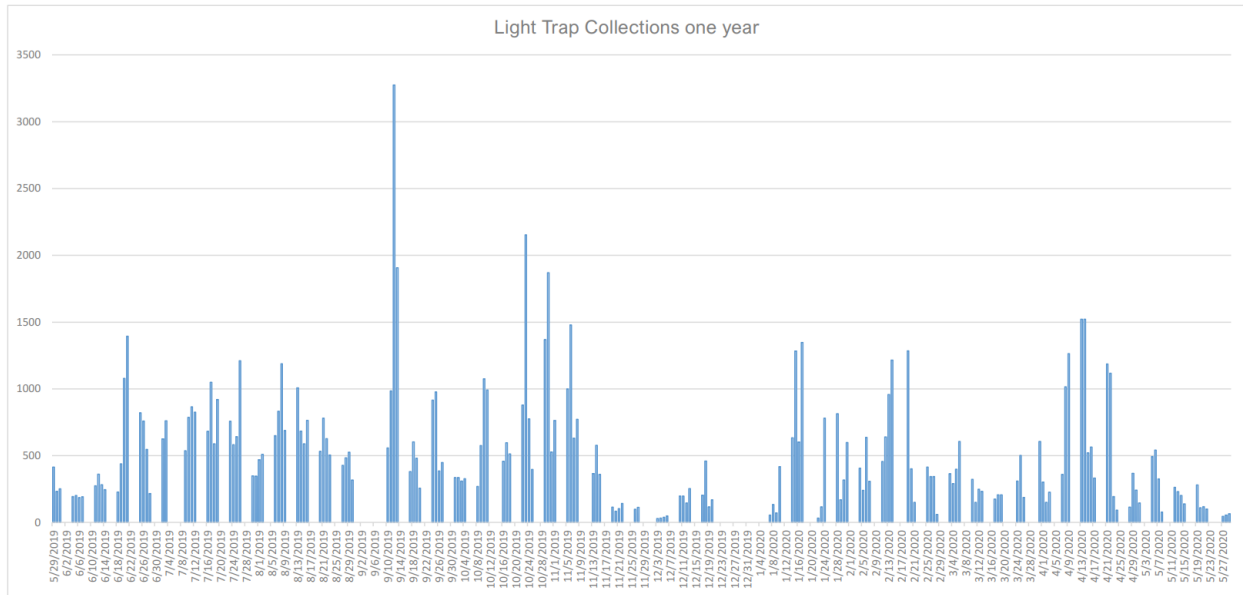
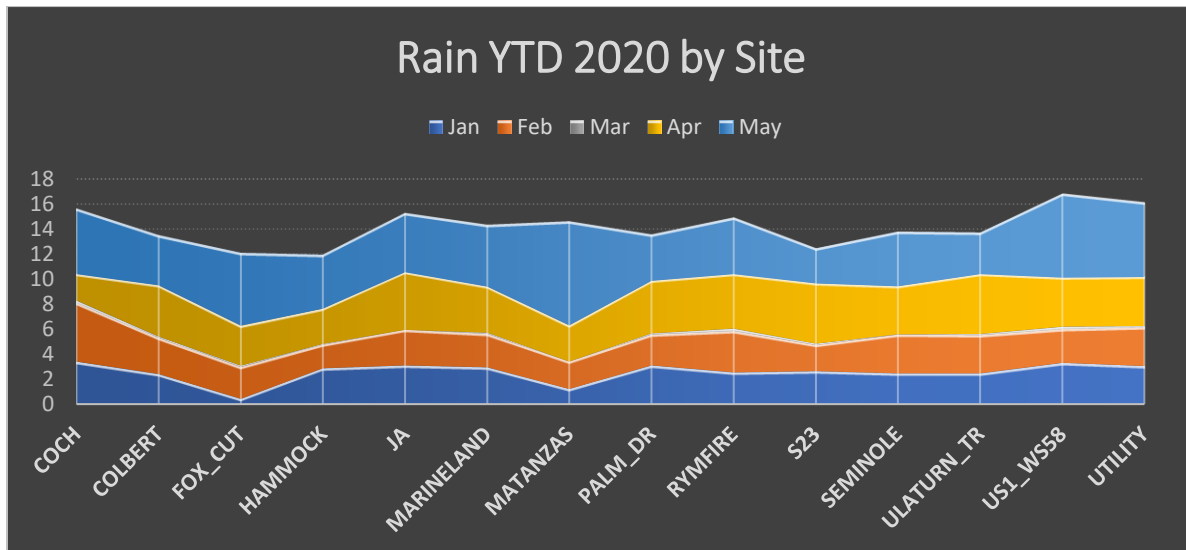


## Week of 5/25/2020 Operations Update

Significant rain this week from a passing Tropical Depression which later became Tropical Storm Bertha. The burn ban was rescinded by the County at the end of the week. Fifth week in a row of no adulticide treatments. The bar graph below shows the total mosquitoes from all traps in the District.



Significant rain was recorded throughout the District the last week of May due to the passing tropical weather system.



The tidal elevation recorded at Bing's landing was above 1.5 feet. This level corresponds to flooding in the higher areas of the saltmarsh that breed salt-marsh mosquitoes periodically.
