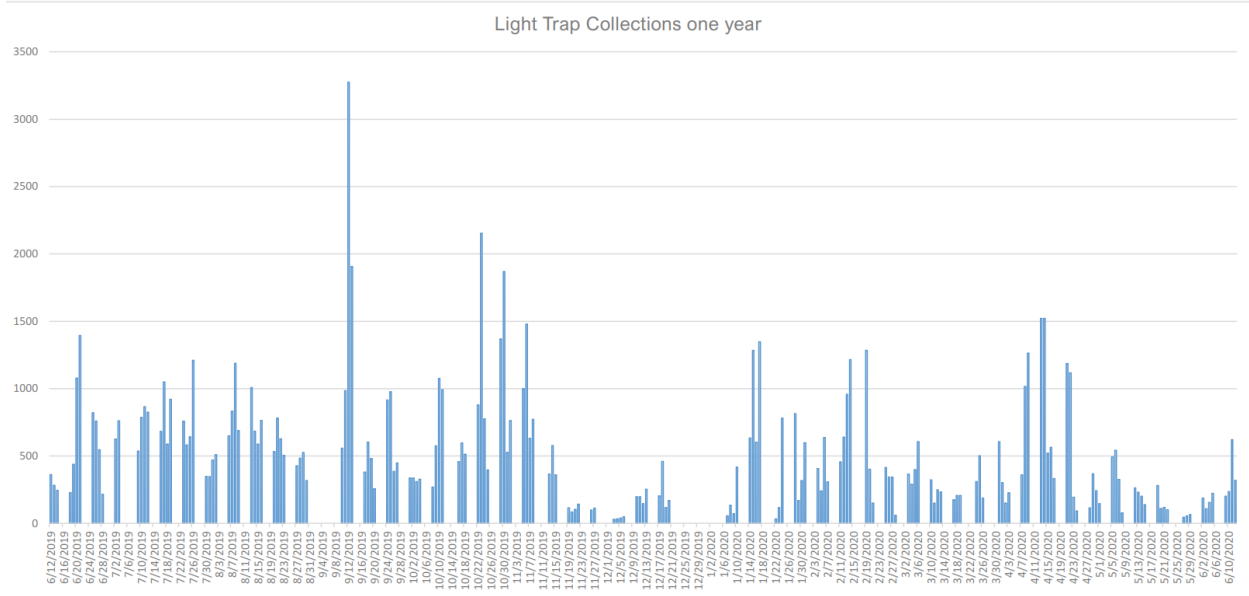
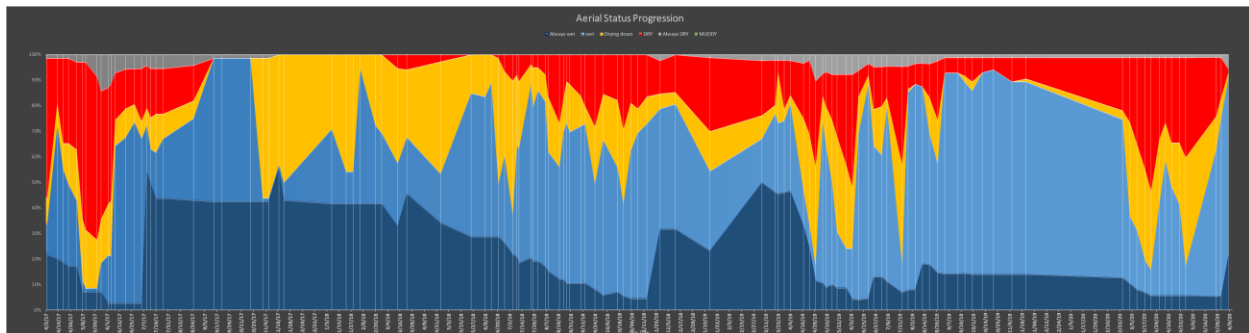


Week of 6/8/2020 Operations Update

A more normal level of mosquito activity for this time of year. Most activity was in the salt marsh areas. The bar graph below shows the total mosquitoes from all traps in the District.



Tropical Storms Bertha and Cristobal brought much needed rain and high tides resulting in flooding of the areas of the salt marsh that breed mosquitoes. The chart below depicts the status of sites monitored by helicopter in the salt marsh. Approximately 90% of the large salt marsh sites are wet.



Zones in in blue were sprayed by truck after 10 PM, yellow zones were sprayed by truck after 2 AM.
