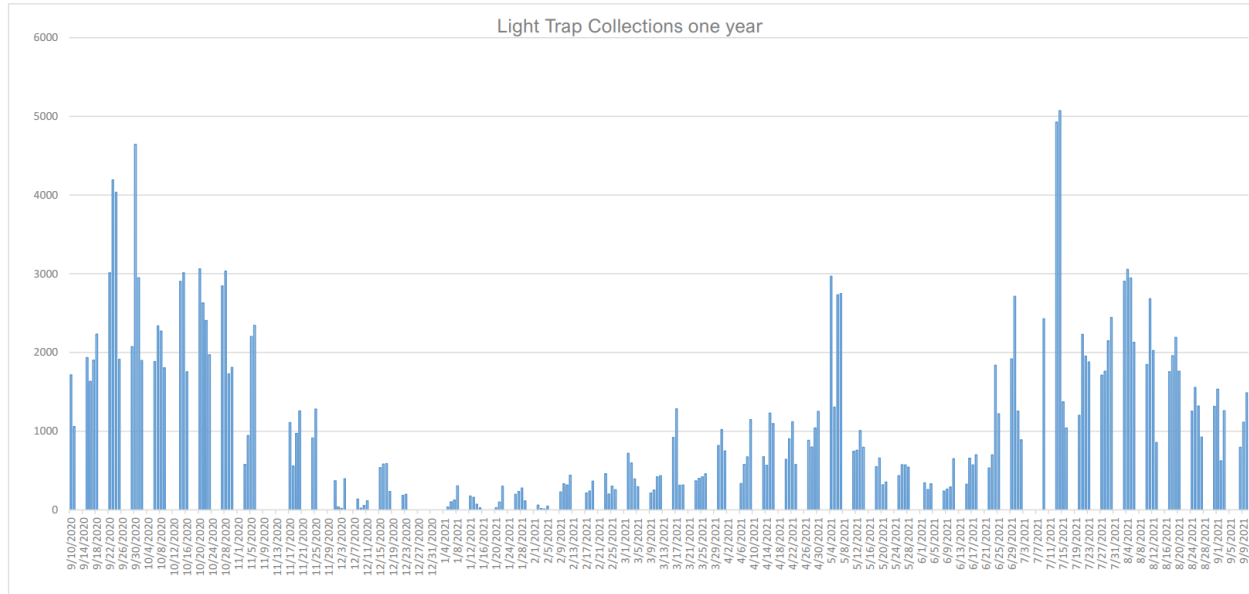
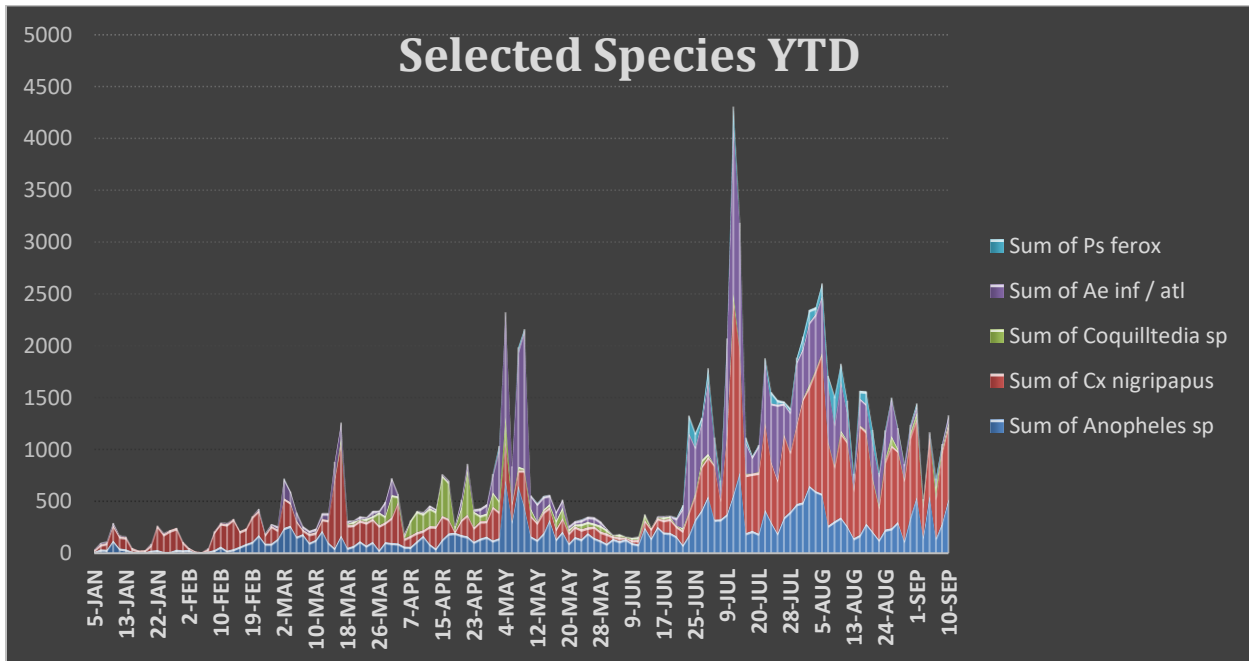


## Week of 9/6/2021 Operations Update

The permanent-water species *Culex nigripalpus* was the main species of mosquito trapped this week. The bar graph below shows the total adult mosquitoes from all traps in the District for the past year (TTM).



The permanent-water species *Culex nigripalpus* made up the largest share of the total mosquito population again this week (chart below). The population numbers for this species have been consistent since mid-July when accumulated rains persisted providing ample breeding grounds for this species to perpetuate.
