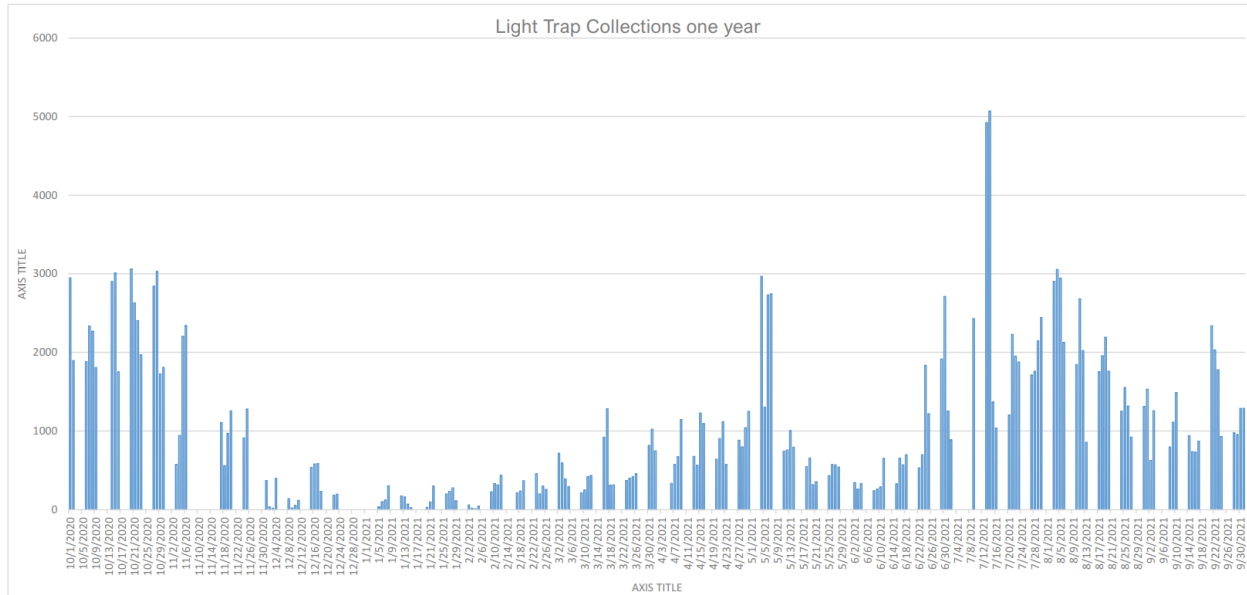
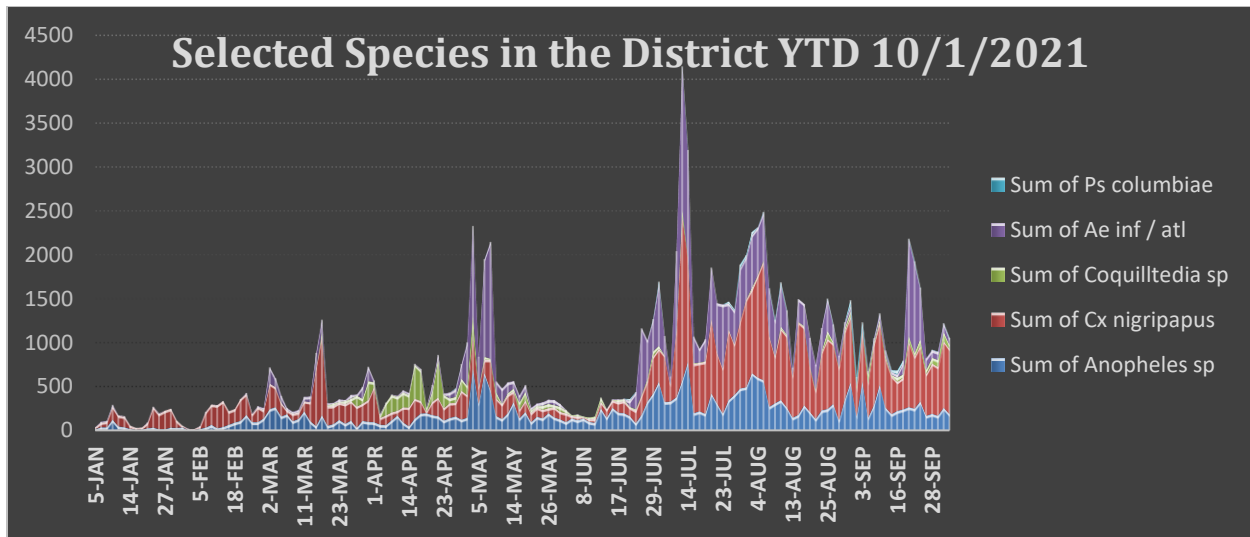


Week of 9/27/2021 Operations Update

A much-reduced population of *Aedes infirmatus* this week following last week's aerial treatments. The bar graph below shows the total adult mosquitoes from all traps in the District for the past year (TTM).



A slight presence of the flood-water species *Aedes infirmatus* was noticeable in the trap for Matanzas Woods this week (graph below). This part of the District has been quiet recently even though aerial treatments were conducted the previous week, primarily in the Southern portions. A slow building *Culex nigripalpus* population was evident as the week progressed.
